

1. Who we are

Enter the Chamber (“we”, “us”, “our”) is the umbrella for four related works: – Project Chamber (lived – art, language, structure) – Chamber Coherence (applied – work with people and systems) – Chamber Architecture (method – patterns and constructs) – Chamber Worlds (experiences – stories and worlds). 2. What this policy covers

This policy explains: – what personal data we collect – how we use it – how we store it – your rights under data protection law (including GDPR, if you are in the EU/EEA).

3. What data we collect

We collect and process different types of personal data depending on how you interact with the Chamber: a) When you “enter the Chamber” (email sign-up) – Name – Email address – Any information you choose to include in optional fields (for example, what brought you here). b) When you apply to work with Chamber Coherence – Name – Email address – Business / organisation details (if you choose to share them) – Information you provide about your situation, goals, and challenges. c) When you visit the website Depending on your cookie choices and browser settings, we may collect: – IP address – Device and browser type – General location (country / region) – Pages visited and actions taken on the site via tools such as HubSpot and website analytics.

4. How we use your data

We use your data to: – send you the Enter the Chamber book and related emails when you enter the Chamber – share new work from Project Chamber, Chamber Coherence, Chamber Architecture, and Chamber Worlds – respond to enquiries and applications to work together – schedule and deliver 1:1 or group work (for Chamber Coherence) – understand how people are interacting with the website and emails, so we can improve them. We do not sell your personal data.

5. Legal bases for processing (GDPR)

Where GDPR applies, we rely on: – Consent – for sending newsletters and occasional emails when you enter the Chamber or opt into specific updates. – Contract – when we process data in order to deliver services you have agreed to (e.g. a Chamber Coherence session). – Legitimate interest – for basic analytics and site security, where this does not override your rights and freedoms. You can withdraw your consent to emails at any time by using the unsubscribe link in any email or by contacting us.

6. How we store and protect your data

We store your data in tools such as: – HubSpot (CRM, email and forms) We choose providers who have appropriate security measures in place. Access is limited to those who need it to run the Chamber (currently: you, and anyone else if relevant). We keep data only for as long as it is needed for the purposes described in this policy, or as required by law.

7. Data sharing and transfers

We do not sell or rent your personal data. We may share data with: – service providers who support our work (e.g. hosting, email, CRM, payment processors), under appropriate data protection agreements – professional advisers (e.g. legal, accounting) where necessary. Some of these providers may be based outside the EU/EEA. Where this is the case, we will take steps to ensure appropriate safeguards are in place (for example, standard contractual clauses or equivalent protections).
